The council discussed the crossing guard resolution where the city and school system agree to share the cost for crossing guards. The members also reviewed the crossing guard placements. Many students are crossing one block north of the crossing on 8th street. Ms. Browning said she would watch and evaluate the Ave. I crossing.

The group decided to move forward with the School newspaper plan and will seek a staff sponsor.

Ms. Browning asked the members about increased security in the building in lieu of the recent school violence. She stated that the Crisis Team/Safety Committee will be studying locking all doors but one for a defensible entry. The group generally thought the increased security was worth the potential inconvenience.
