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2020 BMS Basketball Protocols

- All players will be required to wear masks during practice when not involved in strenuous activity. Temperature checks will also be administered before practices.
- Face coverings are required by coaches and players when not in competition.
- Essential personnel will only be allowed in the bench area
- Team members should try to maintain distancing on the bench.
- Temperatures and symptoms must be checked by visiting teams before departing and documented for all team personnel.
- Water will not be provided. A bottle fill station is located adjacent to the gym in the south hallway.
- A designated “cool down” area will be available when an athlete comes out of a game before they re-mask.
- No pre-game or post-game handshakes/high-fives/fist bumps.
- Team personnel and fans are recommended to leave the area as soon as the contest is over.
- Fans will be expected to leave at the conclusion of their student athlete’s contest (A, B)
- **Masks are required for entry to our games. Fans will be required to wear a mask while in the gym and socially distance between family groups.**
- **Fans will be limited to four per participant. Names will be provided by coaches in advance of the contests. Fan attendance for all indoor youth extracurricular activities is limited to household members of participants only.**
- There will be NO concessions at activities hosted at BMS due to lack of eating/drinking space outside of the gym
- Any individual feeling ill or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 are advised to not attend
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the scorer’s table for officials, game help and coaches.
- Basketballs and other necessary equipment will be routinely sanitized during practices and games. A limited number of basketballs will be in use during practices.
- We will follow all NSAA COVID-19 Rules Modifications and Considerations
- Capacity will be capped at 25%.
